

## Course Setting with OCAD Seminar Latvia

### Course Setting with different Scales

- Finish course planning before splitting the files !!!
- Split the map file (ex. 1:15'000 / 1:10'000)
- Split the course setting project
- Re-Open the background map with the corresponding scale
- Compare the files before printing

#### **Scales 15'000 / 10'000**

→ Circle size 5mm / 7.5mm (ISOM 2017)

#### **Scales 10'000 / 7500**

→ Circle size 6 mm / 8 mm (inofficial)

#### **Scale 10'000**

→ Circle size 7.5 mm (ISOM 2017)

#### **Scale 4000 or 5000**

→ Circle size 6 mm (ISSOM 2007)

→ ISSOM 20xx revision: circle size ?? mm

## Prepare Courses for Printing

- All course objects are placed exactly at the centre of feature
- Control description complete for all control points (incl. Start)
- Cut control circles if they cover important map details
- Cut connection lines if they cover important map details
- Avoid connection lines that cross other controls
- Place the control numbers as well as possible
- All marked routes are properly defined (running direction) and added to the courses
- All Out-of-bounds areas, out-of-bounds routes, crossing points and passages are properly defined
- If map changes are used: Map change is added to the course + New start triangle after map change
- First aid points and general refreshment points are added to the map
- Placeholder for control description is placed on the map (optionally). Check that there is enough place for all courses' description.
- Placeholder for the course title (course and/or classes)
- Course Setting → Courses: Climb [m] is set for all courses + ev. extra length [km]
- All classes have assigned the right courses
